

The Chambers County Appraisal District is reminding property owners who have physical damage to their property as a result of the recent severe winter weather to apply for a temporary disaster exemption.

The Texas Property Tax code allows a qualified property that is at least 15 percent damaged by a disaster in a governor-declared disaster area to receive a temporary exemption of a portion of the appraised value of the property. Qualified property includes real property such as homes and buildings, certain manufactured homes and tangible personal property used for the production of income for a business.

The property owner must apply to receive the temporary exemption with the appraisal district no later than May 28, 2021.
